Lurleen B. Wallace Community College has received, signed, and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement. The institution has used funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

The College received \$773,069 under the CRRSAA program on January 17, 2021, and \$2,636,210 under the ARP program on May 12, 2021.

(3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).

During the first quarter of 2022, the College distributed \$952,880 to students under the ARP program.

(4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

A total of 1,635 students (Spring 2022) are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under ARP.

(5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

During the first quarter of 2022, 1,635 students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants under ARP.

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.

In accordance with Department of Education guidelines, the College prioritized student financial need when determining aid amounts and used eligibility for Title IV funding as the primary factor for identifying high-need students; 1,054 non-Pell students each received \$430, and 581 Pell students each received \$860.

(7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) was authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, that was signed into law on March 22, 2021. This act allows LBWCC to provide emergency financial aid grants in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In early March, we anticipate that the College will distribute funds to all students registered in classes this spring. The amount of the grant is unknown at this time. You are **strongly encouraged** to enter your direct deposit information in your MyLBWCC (OneACCS) account in order to receive these funds more quickly. Students without direct deposit will be mailed checks to addresses on file and funds could be delayed up to two weeks. Information regarding the setup of direct deposit is included below.
