Lurleen B. Wallace Community College has received, signed, and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement. The institution has used funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

**(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.**

The College received \$773,069 under the CRRSAA program on January 17, 2021, and \$2,636,210 under the ARP program on May 12, 2021.

**(3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs as of the date of submission (*i.e.*, as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).**

During the third quarter of 2021, the College distributed \$684,000 to students under the ARP program.

**(4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.**

A total of 969 students (Summer 2021) are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under ARP.

**(5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.**

During the third quarter of 2021, 969 students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants under ARP.

**(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.**

In accordance with Department of Education guidelines, the College prioritized student financial need when determining aid amounts and used eligibility for Title IV funding as the primary factor for identifying high-need students; 570 non-Pell students each received \$500, and 399 Pell students each received \$1,000.

**(7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.**

Students received notification from the Dean of Student Affairs regarding the Emergency Financial Aid Grants. Sample emails are included below.

Students,

After reviewing guidance, we've determined that all students are eligible to receive this emergency grant aid. Grants are being distributed in the amount of \$1,000 for Pell eligible students and \$500 for students not eligible to receive Pell grants.

I have been informed that the business office has begun working on processing ARP HEERF III grants. You may begin seeing these refunds in your myLBWCC (OneACCS) accounts today. We anticipate that direct deposits will be processed today. However, once we initiate the direct deposit, we do not know how long it will take for funds to appear in your bank account. For students without direct deposit, we will begin printing checks tomorrow. Once complete, we cannot predict a delivery timetable for the US Postal Service.
