

MEASURES OF STUDENT SUCCESS

Lurleen B. Wallace Community College values its mission to provide students with quality academic and technical instruction. The College has identified eight student achievement goals that reflect its commitment to preparing students for further education and the workforce:

- Measure 1) Employer perception of technical programs
- Measure 2) Fall-to-spring retention
- Measure 3) Fall-to-fall retention
- Measure 4) Cumulative GPA
- Measure 5) Employment
- Measure 6) Licensure
- Measure 7) Graduation
- Measure 8) Transfer

These goals are measured annually by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality. Graduation and transfer rates are disaggregated by gender, race/ethnicity, and socioeconomic status. All data are reviewed by the Student Achievement Committee annually and disseminated among faculty and staff.
