PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT POLICY

All students planning to attend Lurleen B. Wallace Community College are assessed through a 3-level screening guideline process.

EXEMPTION: Students who have taken the ACT and scored 18 or higher in English and 20 or higher in mathematics will be exempt from taking the ACCUPLACER placement assessment. ACT scores cannot be older than five years. Copies of the ACT documenting these scores must be provided to the Admissions Office in advance of taking the test and prior to registration.

Students can be placed into certain math and English courses based on high school transcripts with a GPA of 2.75 or higher and a grade of "C" or higher in the appropriate high school class(es). Official high school transcripts must be provided to the Admissions Office to determine this placement, and transcripts cannot be older than five years.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE ALL PARTS OF THE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT, UNLESS YOU PROVIDE PROPER DOCUMENTATION PRIOR TO TESTING.

- Students must complete an [application for admission](#) **before** taking the placement test. Admission application must be submitted to the college prior to your planned testing date, so that an LBWCC student number may be issued.
- Students may take the ACCUPLACER placement assessment at any of our campus locations (Andalusia, Greenville, or Opp). Students must schedule an appointment at the following website: www.picktime.com/lbwccassessment or scan the QR code to book your testing appointment.
- On test day, you will be required to show a valid picture ID and have your LBW student number. The assessment is not timed, and the scores will become a part of your student record to be used for placement in the appropriate English and mathematics courses.
- There is no charge for the first test. A student who wishes to challenge placement results may retest once, provided there is evidence the student has completed test preparation activities. Additional preparation includes, but is not limited to, academic boot camps, online pre-tests, and placement test applications. The cost to retest is \$8.00.
- The ACCUPLACER Student Portal link below provides information and resources to help you prepare for the ACCUPLACER placement tests. Through the portal you can access free practice tests, learning resources, and sample questions, as well as practice using the calculator to familiarize yourself with the calculator functions available during the test. Practicing ahead of time can help improve efficiency and accuracy during the exam.
