GED Testing Information

General Educational Development Testing (GED)

LBW Community College offers the 2014 GED Test. The new computer-based GED test replaced the paper-based 2002 version. The new test measures the critical-thinking and problem-solving skills that colleges and employers are looking for. The test is comprised of four content areas:

- Reasoning Through Language Arts (RLA) (150 minutes)
- Mathematical Reasoning (115 minutes)
- Science (90 minutes)
- Social Studies (90 minutes)

Benefits Of The New Testing Format:

- Alignment from day one to national and state college and career readiness standards
- Same day scoring
- Detailed score report including college and career readiness information
- Flexible testing and pay as you go options

Testing Dates: GED tests are administered on the third Tuesday of each month at the MacArthur Campus in Opp.

Registration: Persons eligible to take the test must **register in advance** via the GED website at www.ged.com or by calling 1-877-EXAMGED (1-877-392-6433).

Qualifications: Must be 18 years old and officially withdrawn from high school. Underage candidates (*16 or 17 year old*) must turn in all required documentation to the GED testing center.

Cost: The cost of the test is \$120 for the complete battery or \$30 per content area. There are 4 content areas which can be taken individually or as selected by the examinee. Examinees must register online at www.ged.com or call 1-877-EXAMGED (392-6433) to register, schedule and pay for the GED test on computer. Credit and debit cards are acceptable forms of payment.

Identification: Driver's license or any valid government issued photo identification and Social Security Card.

Location: LBW Community College administers the GED test on the MacArthur campus in Opp, AL. The test center is located in Building F, Room F-4 at 1708 North Main Street, Opp, AL 36467.
