PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT POLICY

All students planning to attend Lurleen B. Wallace Community College are assessed through a 3-level screening guideline process.

A VALID PICTURE ID & LBWCC STUDENT NUMBER ARE REQUIRED FOR TESTING

EXEMPTION: Students who have taken the ACT and scored 17 or higher in English and 19 or higher in Mathematics will be exempt from taking the assessment. ACT scores cannot be older than five years. Copies of the ACT documenting these scores must be provided to the Admissions Office in advance of taking the test and prior to registration.

Students can be placed into Math and English courses based on high school transcripts with a GPA of 2.75 or higher and a grade of "C" or higher in the appropriate high school class. High school transcripts used to determine placement can not be older than five years.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE ALL PARTS OF THE PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT, UNLESS YOU PROVIDE PROPER DOCUMENTATION PRIOR TO TESTING.

- Students must complete an [application for admission](#) **before** taking the placement test. Admission application must be submitted to the college prior to your planned testing date, so that an LBWCC student number may be issued.
- Students may take the Placement Assessment at any of our campus locations (Andalusia, Greenville, Luverne, or MacArthur/Opp). Students must schedule an appointment at www.picktime.com/lbwccassessment. **You will be required to show a valid picture ID.** The assessment is not timed, and the scores will become a part of your student record to be used for placement in the appropriate English and Mathematics courses.
- There is no charge for the first test. A student who wishes to challenge placement results may retest once per academic year, provided there is evidence the student has completed test preparation activities. Additional preparation includes, but is not limited to, academic boot camps, online pre-tests, and placement test applications. The cost to retest is \$8.00.
