This program provides students an opportunity to obtain the necessary knowledge and skills to succeed in an industrial welding position. Students will learn the basic safe practices for:

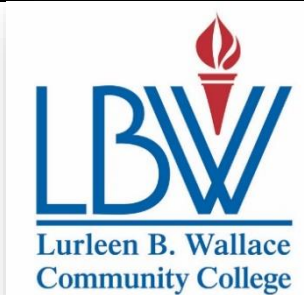
- SMAW: 2F, 3F, 4F, 2G and 3G procedures for stick welding
- GMAW: 2F, 3F, 4F, 2G and 3G procedures for MIG welding
- Oxy-fuel cutting operations
- Grinding operations
- Basic construction math, including proper use of tape measure
- Soft Skill Training

Students will have the opportunity to earn recognized skills certificates awarded by a Certified Welding Inspector (CWI).
