



Summer Incentive Grant

The LBWCC Foundation Summer Incentive Grant was established to assist students during the summer 2019 semester. This grant provides students the chance to take one three-credit hour class and get a three credit-hour class paid for by the LBWCC Foundation. The incentive applies to current LBWCC students, 2019 high school graduates, transient students (defined as those who attend a four-year institution and are home for the summer), and rising high school juniors and seniors participating in academic dual enrollment or accelerated program. To be considered for the grant, students must complete **all** requirements listed below and submit the Summer Incentive Grant Application to the Financial Aid Office on the campus they plan to attend. The grant will be awarded on a first-come-first serve basis and can only be applied after all other forms of gift aid have been depleted. Applicants will be notified of awards through their LBWCC Saints email. Students must register for classes and pay their portion of the tuition and fees before May 23, 2019.

Current LBWCC Student Summer Incentive Requirements:

- currently enrolled Spring Semester 2019,
- have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average, and
- complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form (www.fafsa.ed.gov) and include LBWCC's School Code 008988.

2019 High School Graduate Summer Incentive Requirements:

- a completed LBWCC Application for Admission,
- acceptable form of identification; applicants claiming in-state status for tuition purposes must also submit documentation of Alabama residency (for example, an Alabama driver's license),
- placement assessment results or ACT scores of 18 or higher in English & 20 or higher in mathematics, &
- complete and submit the 2018-2019 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form (www.fafsa.ed.gov) and include LBWCC's School Code 008988.

Transient Student Summer Incentive Requirements:

- an official letter or transient form from the parent institution which certifies that the credit earned at LBWCC will be accepted as a part of the student's academic program,
- a completed LBWCC Application for Admission, and
- an acceptable form of identification and documentation of Alabama residency for those applicants claiming in-state status for tuition purposes (for example, an Alabama driver's license).

Rising High School Junior or Senior Summer Incentive Requirements:

(These students must be on schedule to graduate high school in May 2020 or 2021)

For admission to the accelerated program, high school students must:

- complete the LBWCC Application for Admission,
- submit an acceptable form of identification,
- submit a high school transcript documenting completion of the tenth or eleventh grade and the required "B" average,
- submit the Accelerated High School Student Program form, signed by the principal, and
- take the placement assessment and place into the course desired or provide ACT scores which exempt the student from the placement assessment.

For admission to the dual enrollment program, high school students must:

- complete the LBWCC Application for Admission for Dual Enrollment for Dual Credit,
- submit an acceptable form of identification,
- submit a high school transcript documenting grade level and the required 2.5 unweighted GPA,
- submit the Approval for Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit for High School Students form, signed by the principal and superintendent, and
- take the placement assessment and place into the course desired or provide ACT scores which exempt the student from the placement assessment.
