Career Pathways is a program that enables participants an opportunity to attend LBWCC Technical classes and the Career Pathways program while they work to improve their academic skill level or work to earn a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent. The core of Career Pathways is “Integrated Education and Training (IET)”, which includes adult basic education, workforce preparation, and occupational skill instruction. Courses offered as Career Pathways may include: Welding, Certified Medical Assistant, Dental Assistant, Pharmacy Technician, Veterinary Assistant, Cosmetology, Automotive Mechanics, Diesel and Heavy Equipment Mechanics, and Medical Coding programs.
